The County of Hall, Georgia (Owner) is soliciting BIDS for the construction of the following project:

IFB #025-45 HALL COUNTY – MULBERRY CREEK BACK PUMPING

This project includes furnishing of all materials, equipment, labor and means of construction necessary for the construction of the Dove Point Pump Station, 20-inch gravity sewer installation, fire station wet well conversion to a receiving manhole, Reunion pump station abandonment including site and yard piping modifications, modifications to the Mulberry Creek pump station including the installation of a vertical screen, removal of pumps with motors and installation of new dry pit submersible pumps, installation of a compressed air mixing system and spray water system in the wet well and installation of a new 16-inch HDPE and DIP force main and demolition of the surge tank along with site work. Modifications to the Crystal Farms pump station include installation of an insertion valve, construction of two (2) new valve vaults with interconnecting 12-inch DIP force main, new valve vault at HWY 53 and Howington Road. All work includes new electrical, and instrumentation as shown on the plans and specified.

The successful Bidder for this Contract will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond and a Labor and Material Payment Bond, with a corporate surety **licensed to do business in the State of Georgia with a rating of not less than A-** and approved by the OWNER and listed in the latest issue of U.S. Treasury Circular 570, each in the amount of 100% of any awarded contract. Performance and Payment Bonds are NOT required to bid, but will be required after award
